

Mordechai Kedar is a lecturer in the Department of Arabic and Islamic Studies and a Research Associate at the Begin-Sadat Center for Strategic Studies at Bar-Ilan University. He teaches Islam, Islamic Movements, Islamic Ideologies, Mass Media in the Arab World, State and Society in the Arab World, and Gender Issues in Islamic Societies. Dr. Kedar also does research in partnership with the Institute for Counter-Terrorism at the Interdisciplinary Center in Herzilyah and the Jerusalem Institute for Israel Studies. He received his PhD from Bar-Ilan University in 1998 and has written and published several articles and books including: "Our Children Are in Danger: Education as viewed by the Islamic Movement in Israel," and "Arabness in the Syrian Media: Political Messages Conveyed by Linguistic Means." Dr. Kedar served as a Lieutenant Colonel in the IDF Military Intelligence for 25 years, specializing in Arab political discourse, Arab mass media, Islamic groups and the Syrian domestic arena.
