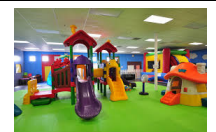

Passover Rice Information 2016 As per phone conversations with rice importers, **Rabbi Eliyahu Ben Haiim** has confirmed that the following brands of rice are 100% pure, no additives, or preservatives, or vitamins. Therefore, they are suitable for use for Passover. **The following brands are: Royal – Pari – Deer – Zebra – Empire - Colbeh Brand – Lal Qilla– Dunar - Dunar Brown – Kohinoor.** Even though these rices are pure, Jewish law requires that the rice be cleaned three times and washed thoroughly before use for Passover.
